The Western Association of Women Historians (WAWH) invites proposals for panels, roundtables, posters, workshops, and individual presentations in all fields, regions, and periods of history.

We particularly encourage **non-traditional formats and topics**. These could include panels and roundtables focused on pedagogy, women in academia, public history, digital humanities, academic publishing, career paths, activism, etc. We also strongly encourage participants to replace the traditional 20-minute paper reading with **shorter and more interactive presentation styles**. We expect that all panels will be diverse in their composition.

Priority will be given to proposals for complete or partially complete sessions. Individual papers will be considered secondarily; we strongly encourage participants interested in submitting an individual paper to seek out fellow panelists for collaboration via [our online spreadsheet](#), and to [contact the Program Committee](#) early to ask about possible chairs and/or commentators.
